This morning's service will last around an hour. An offering will be collected during the service. Visitors, please do not feel obliged to contribute, this is for regular friends and members to give to the ministry and outreach of the church.

The Point is our evening service which starts at 7.00pm and will last around an hour. The Point is a more informally styled service.

If you would like someone to pray with you after either service, this is available in the chapel – look for the sign near the front by the worship team, or look for people with prayer ministry team badges.

However, this week a church in Bexleyheath delivered 88kg of food to us with the promise of ongoing support. We feel encouraged that God has this work covered and that our clients' needs are always met.
