

Welcome to Trinity!

We give a warm welcome to regulars and visitors alike. If you are new among us do make yourself known to us and ask for a copy of our Welcome Pack.

This morning's service will last around an hour. We worship together with our children and young people for the first part of the service and then they will leave for their own activities - if you are not sure where to go, follow the crowd out to the Middle Hall and someone will direct you to the right group. Crèche facilities for under-3s are available in the back Hall throughout the service. If your children have not been before, please note that you will need to register them. This can be done in the Middle Hall when you take them out.

Tea and coffee will be served in the Middle Hall after the morning service - everyone is welcome to stay for fellowship.

An audio loop system is installed downstairs, for anyone wearing a suitable hearing aid.

An offering will be collected during the service. Visitors, please do not feel obliged to contribute, this is for regular friends and members to give to the ministry and outreach of the church.

The Point is our evening service which starts at 7.00pm and will last around an hour. The Point is a more informally styled service.

If you would like someone to pray with you after either service, this is available in the chapel - look for the sign near the front by the worship team, or look for people with prayer ministry team badges.

Andrew has had to put on hold his plans to move into working with refugees to resume his former role as coordinator of the ELCO English for Mission training. In fact, Andrew and Sara are sharing the role for the next six months, as the person doing it has left the UK to return to the Netherlands and a replacement is not in place. It is the only way to keep the programme running. We continue to face big challenges in OM Birmingham, with more staff moving on and further visa restrictions limiting people joining ELCO to Europeans. As a family we are all doing well and have seen amazing provision for our financial support for this year.
