

Welcome to Trinity!

We give a warm welcome to regulars and visitors alike. If you are new among us do make yourself known to us and ask for a copy of our Welcome Pack.

Our morning services last around an hour and a quarter. We worship together with our children and young people for the first part of the service and then they will leave for their own activities, unless it is an all age service as indicated on the front of this sheet. If you are not sure where to go, just follow the crowd out to the Middle Hall and the leaders will be there to greet you. Crèche facilities for under-3s are available in the back hall throughout the service, but parents will need to stay with them. If your children have not been before, please note that you will need to register them. This can be done in the Middle Hall when you take them out.

Tea and coffee will be served in the middle hall after the morning service – everyone is welcome to stay for fellowship.

An audio loop system is installed downstairs, for anyone wearing a suitable hearing aid.

An offering will be collected during the service. Visitors, please do not feel obliged to contribute, this is for regular friends and members to give to the life of the church.

Cornerstone @ The Point is our evening service which starts at 7.00pm and will last around an hour and a half. It is a more informally styled service.

If you would like someone to pray with you after either service, this is available in the chapel – look for the sign near the front by the worship team, or look for people with prayer ministry team badges.
